




From Holborn station







Direct route

When leaving the station, take the exit straight ahead (not the one on the right). After leaving the station, turn left onto Kingsway. After walking a couple of minutes turn left onto Sardinia Street. As you follow the road it becomes Lincoln's Inn Fields. Keep going until you reach a building with black metal railings. You have reached the Royal College of Surgeons of England. If you reach the Nuffield College of Surgical Science, you have gone too far.


Clean air route

Alternatively, you can take a low-pollution walking route. From Holborn station, follow the direct route to Remnant Street and turn left. Enter the park, take the path on the right, and walk past the tennis courts. Exit the park on the right, and the College will be directly opposite.

From Charing Cross station







Direct route

Leave the station through the main exit (signposted 'Strand'). Walk through the forecourt and turn right on the Strand. Keep following the Strand walking past the Savoy Hotel. Follow the road as it turns to the left and becomes Aldwych. When you reach Bush House, cross the road onto the right-hand side of Kingsway. Walk past the Peacock Theatre. Take the next right turn into Sardinia Street. As you follow the road as it becomes Lincoln Inn Fields. Keep going until you reach a building with black metal railings. You have reached the Royal College of Surgeons of England. If you reach the Nuffield College of Surgical Science, you have gone too far.

Clean air route

You're in luck. The low-pollution concentration route to the Royal College of Surgeons of England is the same as the direct route.

From Euston station







Direct route

Walk across the station forecourt and exit to the left. Turn left towards Eversholt Street, then right onto it. At Euston Road, cross straight over to Upper Woburn Place. Walk for 10-15 minutes, passing Tavistock Square Gardens and Russell Square. At Holborn Underground station, cross the road to Kingsway. Turn left into Sardinia Street and continue to Lincoln's Inn Fields. Look for a building with black metal railings—the Royal College of Surgeons of England. If you reach the Nuffield College of Surgical Science, you've gone too far.

Clean air route

You're in luck. The low-pollution concentration route to the Royal College of Surgeons of England is the same as the direct route.

Although we'd recommend turning left onto Remnant Street and turn left. Enter the park, take the path on the right, and walk past the tennis courts. Exit the park on the right, and the College will be directly opposite.

From Kings Cross/ St Pancras station







Direct route

For King's Cross, leave the station by the main exit, walk across the station forecourt and turn right on Euston Road. Follow Euston Road for about five minutes, until you reach Euston Fire station. Turn left into Eversholt Street and then follow the walking instructions from Euston station.

For St Pancras, if you leave facing Kings Cross station, turn right twice: once as you leave and again at Euston Road. If facing the British Library, turn left as you leave, then right at Euston Road. If leaving via the Underground ticket office, turn right. Follow Euston Road for about five minutes until you reach Euston Fire station. Turn left into Eversholt Street and follow the walking instructions from Euston station.

Clean air route

Alternatively, you might want to take the lowpollution concentration route to get to the Royal College of Surgeons.

Here is what you need to know

Your arrival

Upon arrival at the College, our friendly reception team will welcome you and assist with your visit. Hunterian Museum

The museum traces the history of surgery from ancient times to modern robotic operations. It is open Tuesday through Saturday, 10am-5pm.
