1. One copy of your Current Curriculum Vitae (Dated)
2. Logbook – Summary of progress mapped to competencies
3. Educational Structured Supervisor’s Report
4. Academic Progress Report for ACFs and ACLs
5. TPD Report
6. PDP
7. CPD with reflections and aligned to GDC requirements
8. 2 Appraisals – please use collated appraisal form on the Dental Public Health ePortfolio
9. ARCP assessment form
10. Form R and Self-declaration
11. CCST calculator

## Dental Public Health Specialty Specific Requirements

### Work based assessments (WBAs):

Requirements are pro-rata for part-time trainees or those who have completed less than 12 months since their last RCP.

Direct observation of procedural skills (DOP)

Case based discussion (CBD)

Multi- source feedback (MSF)

Objective structured dental public health assessment (OSDPHA)
