Face and neck surgery	<p>Chin surgery</p> <p>Ear surgery</p> <p>Neck surgery</p> <p>Nose surgery</p> <p>Other face surgery such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>➤ Facial implants (This may be called alloplastic facial augmentation)</li><li>➤ Facial sculpting to change the jaw-nose relationship (This may be known as facial remodelling or facial contouring surgery)</li><li>➤ Implant into your bone (This may be known as alloplastic augmentation of the facial skeleton)</li><li>➤ Taking bone from one part of your body and moving it to part of your face (This may be known as bone grafting of the facial skeleton)</li><li>➤ Taking fat from one part of your body and moving it to your face (This may be known as free fat grafting to the face )</li><li>➤ Using fat from your body to plump up the face (This may be known as autologous fat transfer )</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Plastic surgery or</li><li>• Otolaryngology (surgical procedures that deal with the ears, nose, throat and neck) or</li><li>• Oral and maxillofacial surgery (surgical procedures that deal with the mouth, jaws, face and neck)</li></ul>
