Examiner Job Description and Person Specification

Background

The Diploma in Special Care Dentistry (DSCD) is a dental diploma offered by The Royal College of Surgeons of England, involving a self-directed learning programme and examination.

Part A is based on a syllabus divided into 7 modules. Assessment will be by submission of an assignment on each module.

Part B consists of a multiple short answer paper; a simulated clinical examination followed by an oral examination; a general oral exam and another oral exam on two clinical log diary cases.

Job Description

- 1. All examiners are required to commit to an initial term of six years, plus one renewal term of three years, commencing from the date of appointment.
- 2. Examiners are accountable to the Chair of the Examiner Panel.
- 3. The work and time commitment of an examiner is as follows:
 - To examine the written and oral section of the examination for two days per year.
 - To attend an initial training event before examining for the first time.
 - To attend a refresher training event each year (1 day).
 - To attend two examiner panel meetings per year (usually three hour duration held at RCS).
 - To submit new assessment material for the multiple short answer paper and/or the oral elements to the exam.
 - To mark module assignments
 - To design module questions
 - To develop module resources
