A vacancy has arisen for a pivotal role in the management and development of the Restorative Specialty Membership Examinations (M Endo, M Perio and M Pros), of The Royal College of Surgeons of England (RCSEng) and Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Glasgow.

Responsibilities

The role of the Chair is to manage the agenda of the Examination Board and the examinations' effective running and development, by:

- Overseeing the blueprinting of examinations to achieve appropriate syllabus coverage
- Overseeing standard setting procedures and providing guidance in the identification of this standard where necessary
- Overseeing the production of examination reports for the relevant Examinations Committee
- Identifying areas for development within the bank of examination questions, and allocating new questions to be produced by the relevant colleagues accordingly
- Identifying the need for changes to examination content or format, framing the rationale for change and overseeing the completion of an impact analysis
- Contributing to the recruitment and appointment of new Board members
- Contributing to the training of new examiners
- Representing the Examination Board on relevant governance committees as required

Person Specification

- Demonstrable commitment to the relevant examination through participation as an examiner and a Board member
- Interest in medical education and assessment, ideally demonstrated with a relevant postgraduate qualification

The successful applicant will be required to attend up to 10 days of meetings/exams per year.
