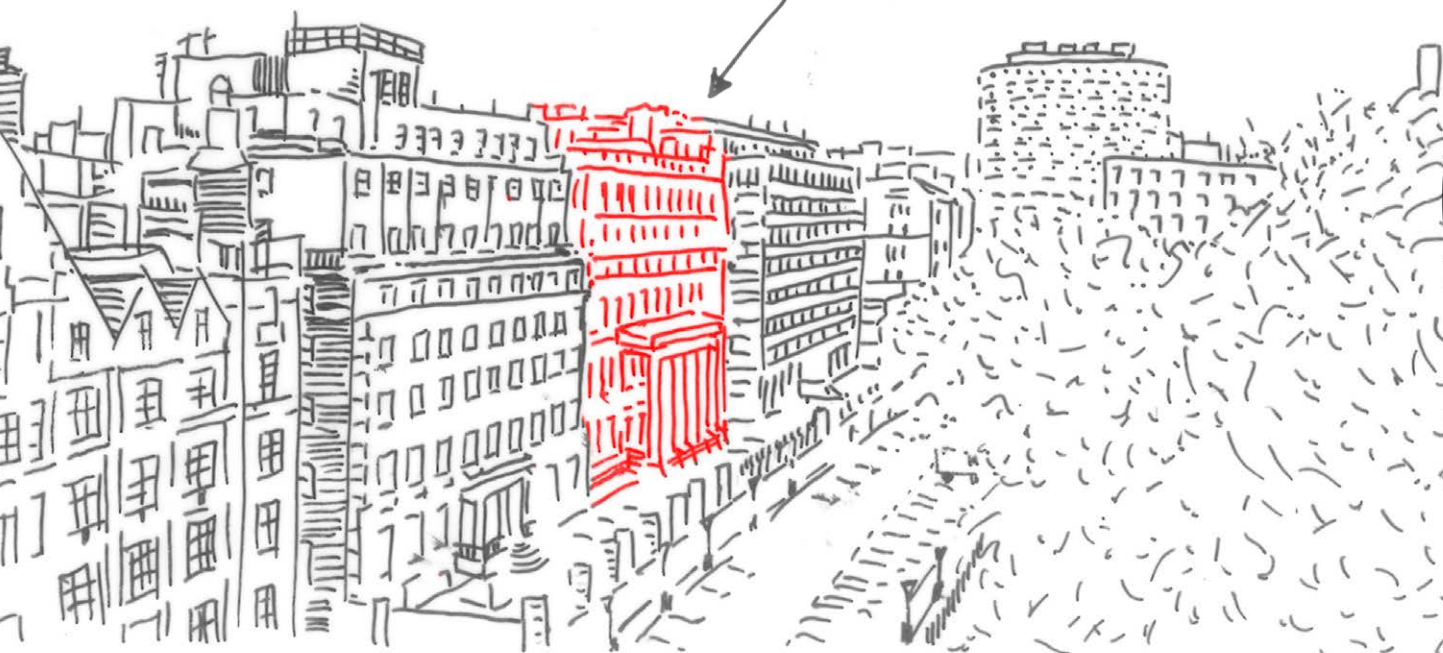

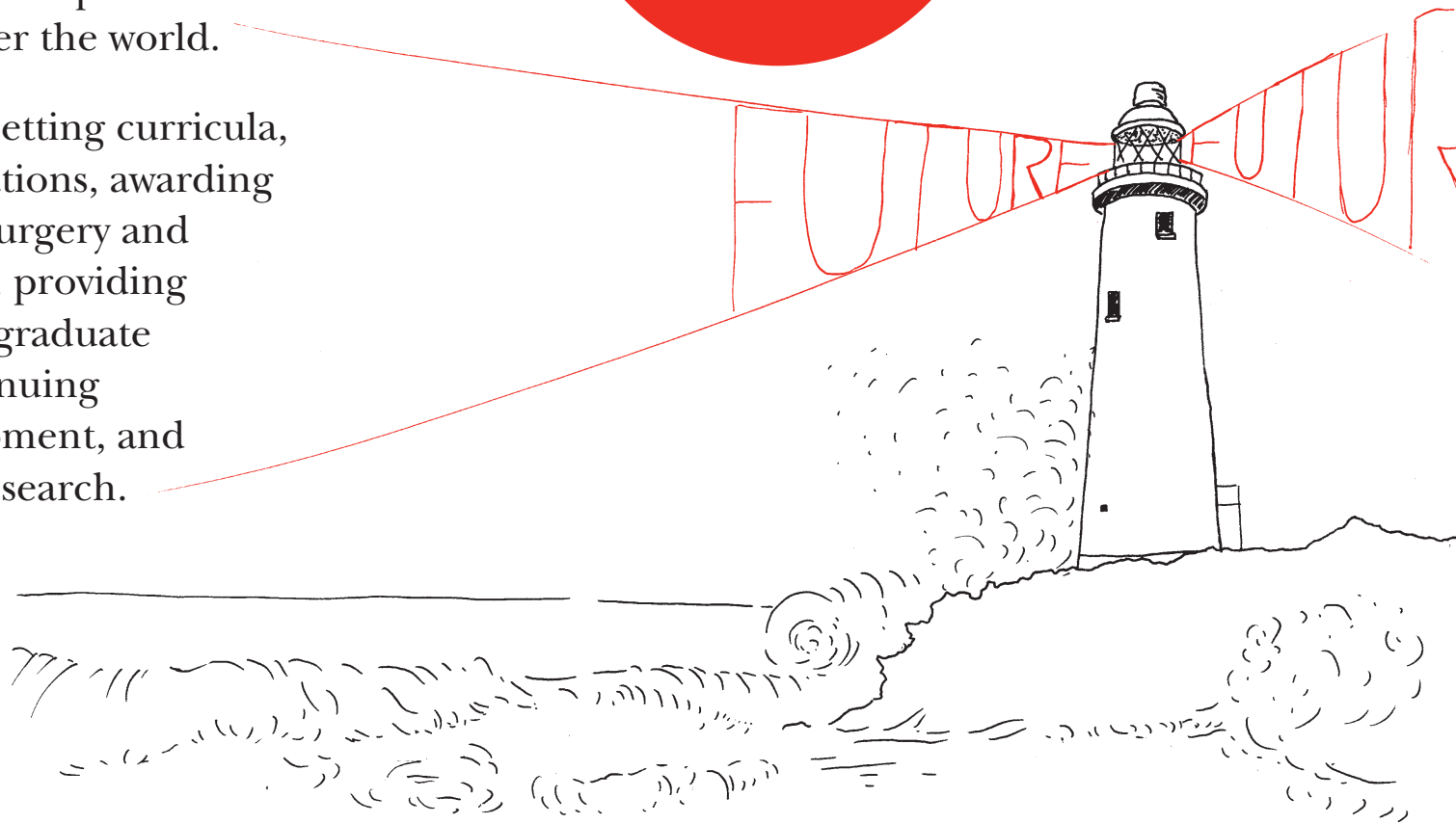


The Faculty of Dental Surgery

The FDJ

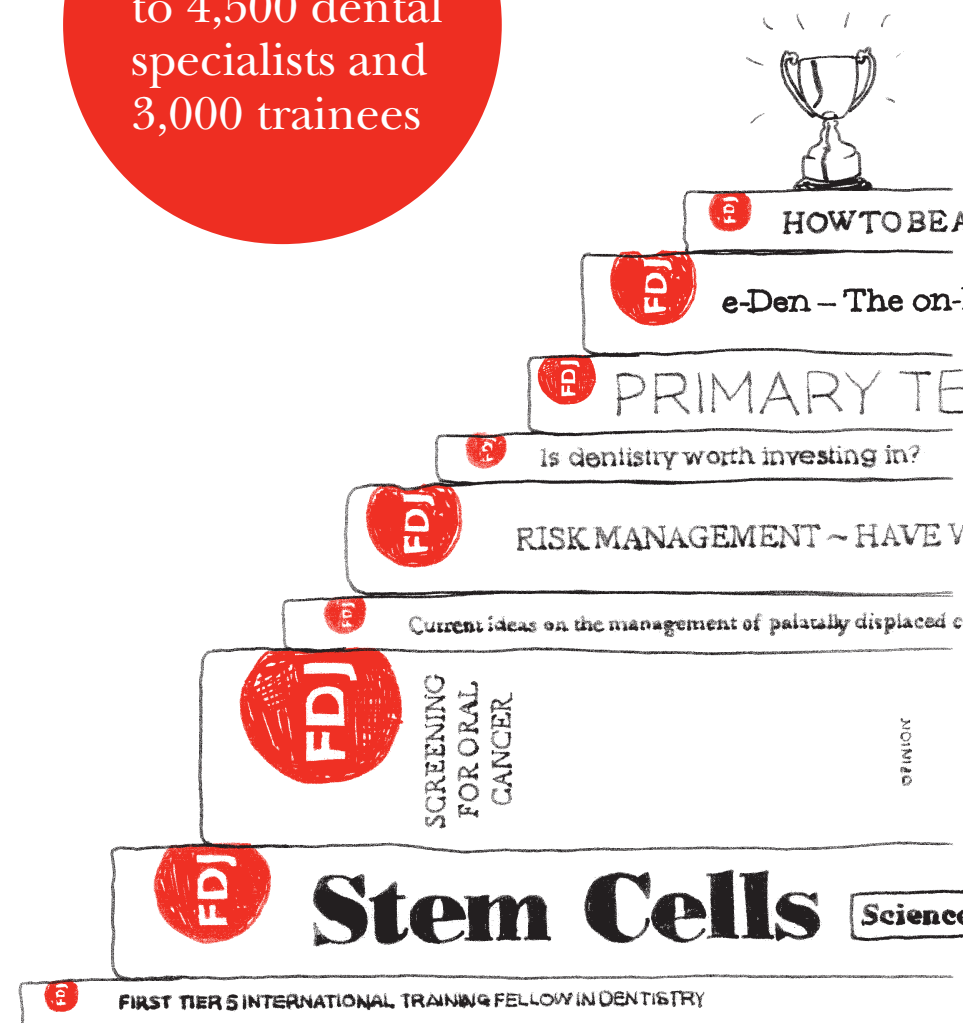
The *FDJ* is our membership journal, providing expert opinion on contemporary issues and controversies relevant to the whole dental community.

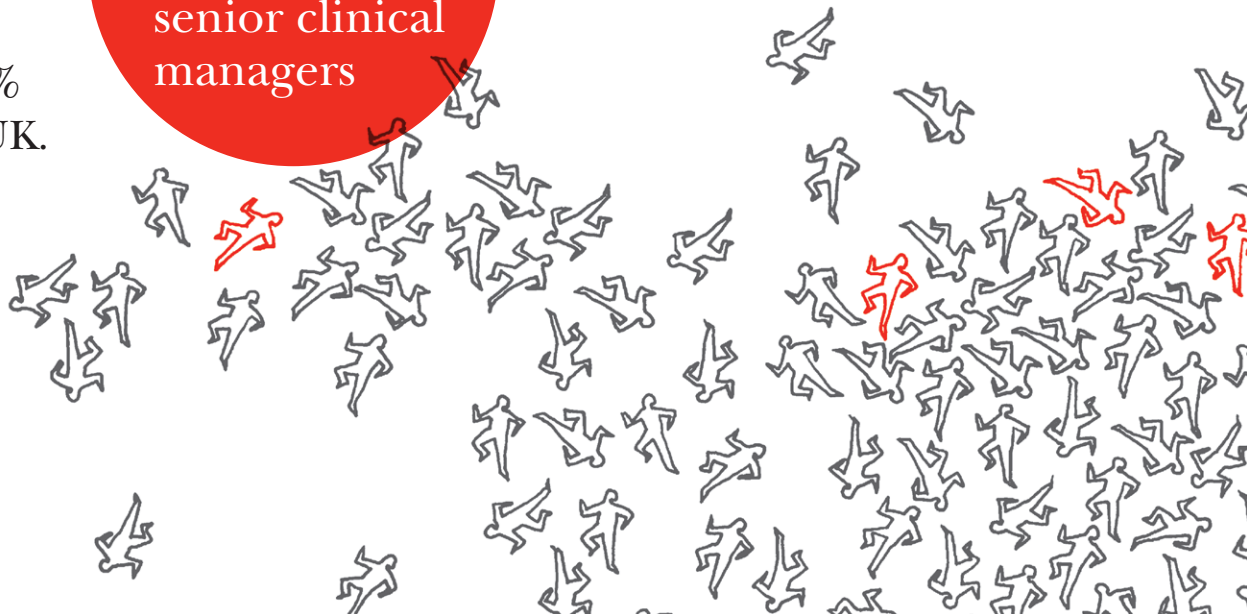
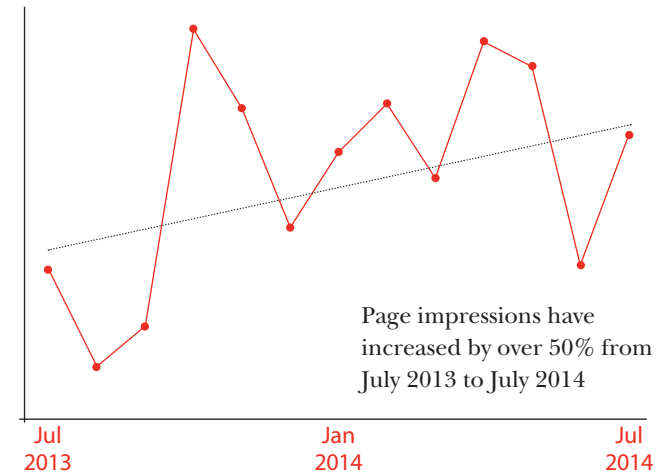
The Faculty of Dental Surgery has over 4,500 members, all of whom receive the *FDJ*.

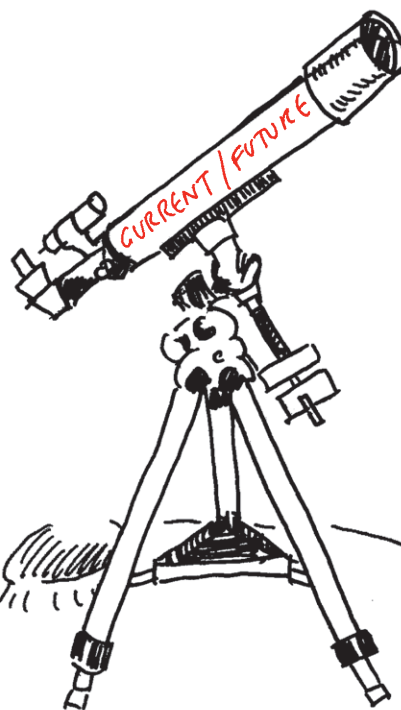
