The conference main theme builds on from the work of the Lancet Commission on Global Surgery, launched in 2015, as an attempt to summarise the different responses and projects undertaken one year after the Lancet report on global surgery.

Alongside the conference, we will be displaying the best 10 posters from surgical trainees, medical students, and researchers with a particular interest in Global Surgery, focused on the theme: **‘Trauma in LMIC’s**.

The best 10 abstracts will be invited to present a poster on the proposed topic, which will be displayed during the Global Surgical Frontiers Conference. A final prize in the amount £250 towards RCS Courses will be awarded to the best two posters. The winners will also be asked to deliver a 10-minute presentation on their poster at the Global Surgical Frontiers Conference.
